Terms and Conditions for the installation of Amusement/Jhullas rides on the eve of Janamashtami

1. The site, for which permission is granted, shall be used only for that purpose.
2. That the Licensee shall abide by any other condition/direction/order that may be imposed in the public interest by Municipal Corporation or the Chandigarh Administration on account of law and order.
3. The successful bidder shall have to deposit the entire amount plus service tax as applicable within a period of two days of the auction in the form of Demand Draft in favour of Commissioner, Municipal Corporation, Chandigarh otherwise the earnest money deposited with the application form shall be forfeited.
4. The applicant shall not sublet the site for which permission is granted, to a third party directly or indirectly.
5. The agency shall not be allowed to construct any pacca structure or shelter in the aforesaid area.
6. The Applicant shall be responsible for protecting the property of the MCC during the permitted period and he shall be liable to pay in case of damage, if any. The damage will be assessed by Additional Commissioner/Joint Commissioner in consultation with the Engineering Department of MCC.
- 6 The applicant shall ensure that there is no mismanagement, misconduct, misbehavior or any obnoxious act on his part or by employee(s) appointed by him. In case of any report/complaint, the decision of the Additional Commissioner/Joint Commissioner, MCC for imposing any penalty or such other action as may be considered proper in the interest of public services shall be final and acceptable to the applicant. However, the Additional/Joint Commissioner will give an opportunity of hearing to the applicant and his employee(s) before taking any decision.
- 7 The Additional Commissioner/Joint Commissioner, MCC or any authorized officer/official may enter upon the premises at any reasonable time and in any reasonable manner to inspect the premises for ascertaining that the applicant is duly observing terms and conditions of permission.
- 8 The applicant shall take separate permission for displaying advertisement(s)/ logo as per the Chandigarh Advertisement Control Order-1954 during the period of permission.
- 9 No stall / commercial activity other than the permission shall be allowed
- 10 The erection / running of Jhullas and dismantling / removal of the equipments shall be made within the permitted period.
- 11 The period of allotment shall not be extended under any circumstances.

- 12 Adequate precautionary measures regarding safety standards of Jhullas will be followed. A certificate of safety of equipments from Mechanical point of view should be obtained from the S.D.E. (Mech), MC, Chandigarh prior to installation of Jhullas at the site.
- 13 The agency shall have to obtain the permission from Chandigarh Administration regarding, use of loud speakers, Law & Order, Safety standards of Jhullas etc. prior to installation of Jhullas at the site and from Chief Fire Officer, Municipal Corporation Chandigarh regarding implementation fire safety measure.
- 14 The agency shall be responsible for maintaining cleanliness in the said area during the period of allotment. The licensee shall handover the vacant possession of the area to the concerned Sub Divisional Engineer, Road, Municipal Corporation, Chandigarh on the expiry of allotment of site. The certificate regarding cleanliness of the said area after use be duly obtained from the concerned SDE, Roads be submitted to this office.
- 15 No cancellation/Change of date of booking is permissible in any case once the booking is made for the specific period and no refund is permissible in any case.
- 16 The Municipal Corporation, Chandigarh reserves the right to cancel the booking of ground/open space in Public interest.
- 17 In case any, legal litigation arises at any point of time during the permitted period, the Municipal Corporation, Chandigarh shall in no way responsible for any illegal transaction.
- 18 All disputes and differences arising out or in any way touching upon this permission, whatsoever, shall be referred to the sole arbitration of the Commissioner, Municipal Corporation, Chandigarh or any officer deputed by him to act as Arbitrator. The decision of the Arbitrator shall be final and binding on both the parties. The provisions of Arbitration and Consolation Act, 1996, and Rules framed there-under and any statutory modification/ amendments thereof for the time being in force shall apply for such arbitration.
- 19 All disputes shall be subject to the jurisdiction of courts in Chandigarh only.
